

FILE : HOW TO USE ALTERNATES & LIGATURES

Thank you for using our fonts.

Our fonts include Alternates and Ligatures to enhance your designs.

Follow the quick guide below based on your software.

ADOBE ILLUSTRATOR

1. Type your text using the font.
2. Select the text.
3. Go to Window > Type > Glyphs.
4. Click any character to see available alternates.
5. Double-click an alternate glyph to apply.

For Ligatures:

1. Select the text.
2. Go to Window > Type > OpenType.
3. Enable Standard Ligatures or Discretionary Ligatures.

ADOBE PHOTOSHOP

1. Type your text using the font.
2. Select the text.
3. Go to Window > Glyphs.
4. Double-click an alternate glyph to apply.

For Ligatures:

1. Go to Window > Character.
2. Click the panel menu (top-right corner).
3. Enable OpenType Ligatures.

CANVA

Note: Canva supports automatic ligatures but does not support manual glyph selection.

Ligatures:

1. Type text using the font.
2. Available ligatures will appear automatically.

Alternates:

Currently, Canva does not support manual alternate selection.

For full alternate access, use Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop.

FIGMA

1. Type text using the font.
2. Select the text.
3. In the right panel, click ... (Advanced Type Settings).
4. Enable Ligatures if available.

Alternates:

Currently, Figma does not provide manual glyph selection.

For full alternate access, use Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop.

TIPS:

For the best experience using alternates & ligatures, we recommend Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop.
