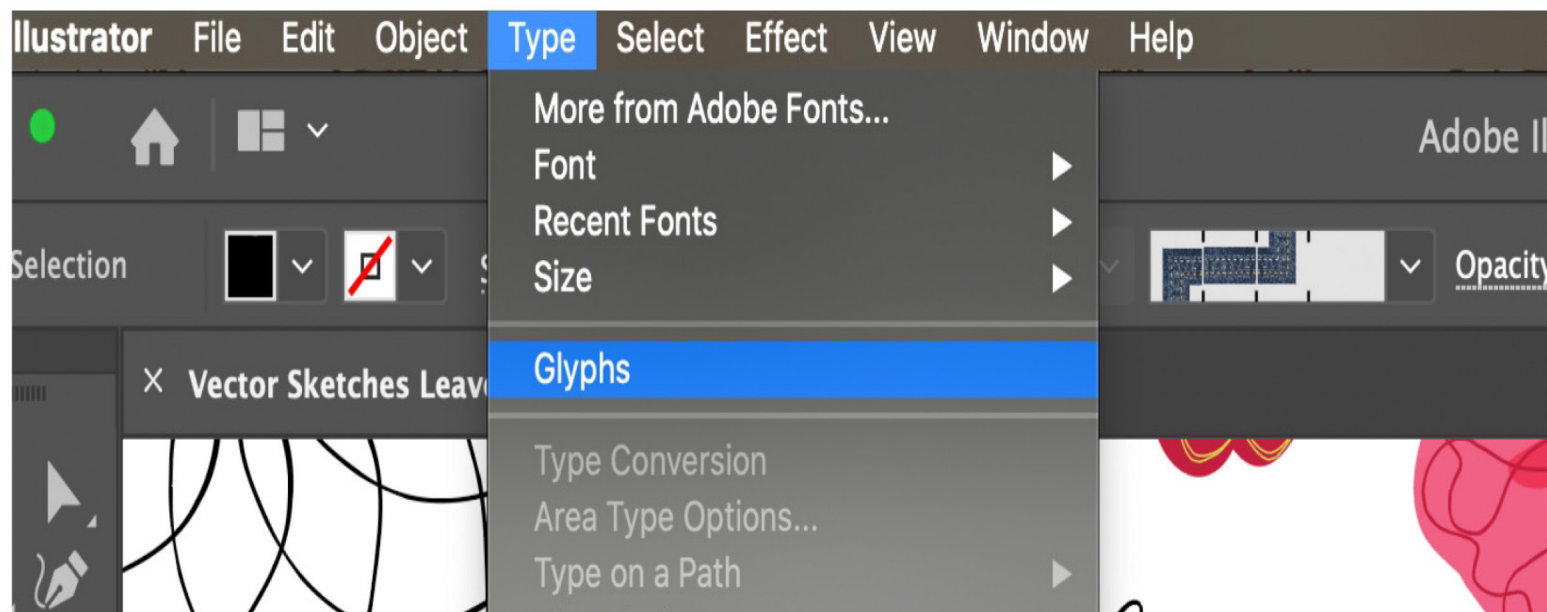


IF you want to display Ligatures, swashes and multilingual, you must display **"Glyph or Symbols"** Firts.

1. Adobe Illustrator

To open the glyphs panel select Type > Glyphs.

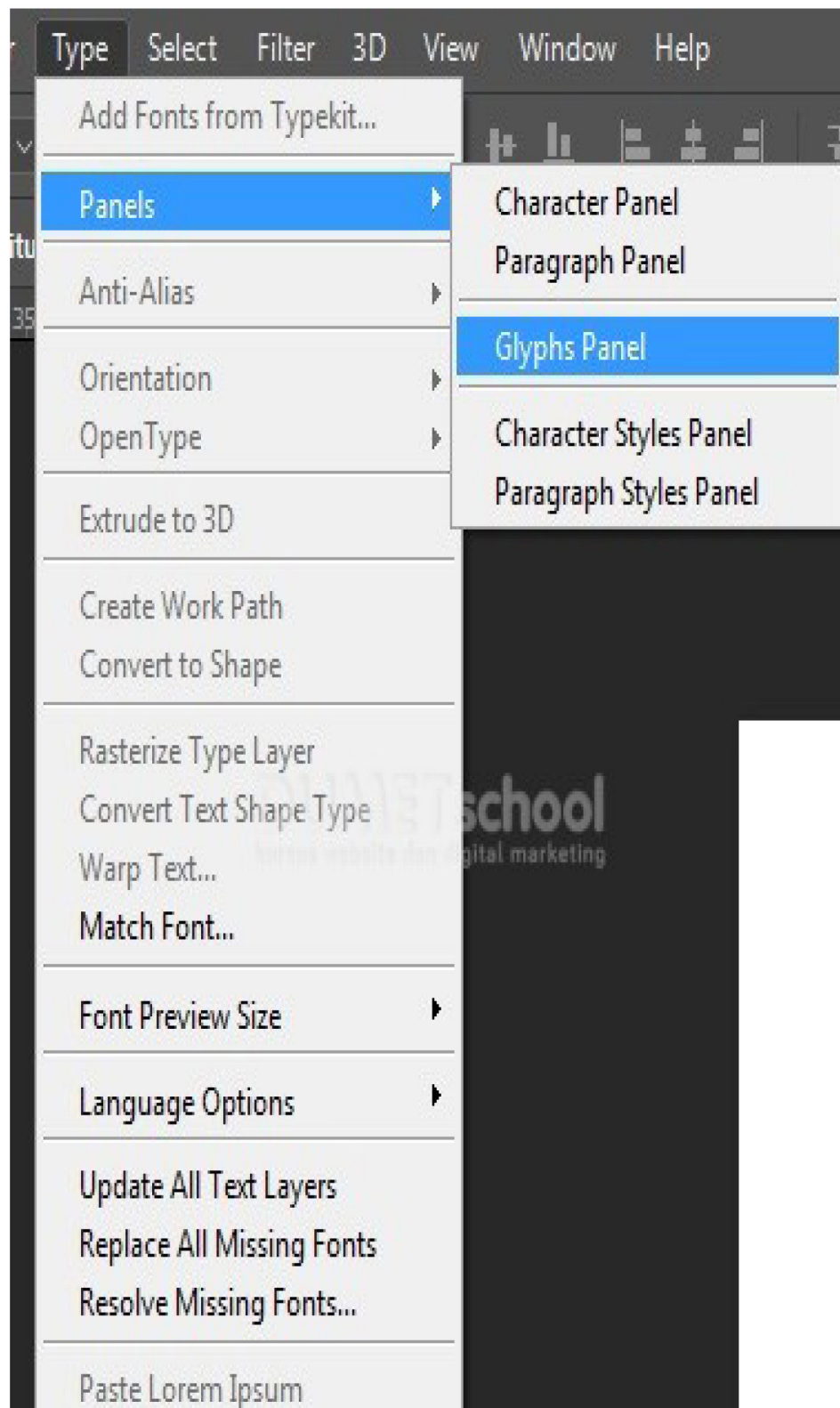


Simply position the text box on your artboard and double-click on the glyph of your choice. Illustrator will insert your selected glyph into the text box.



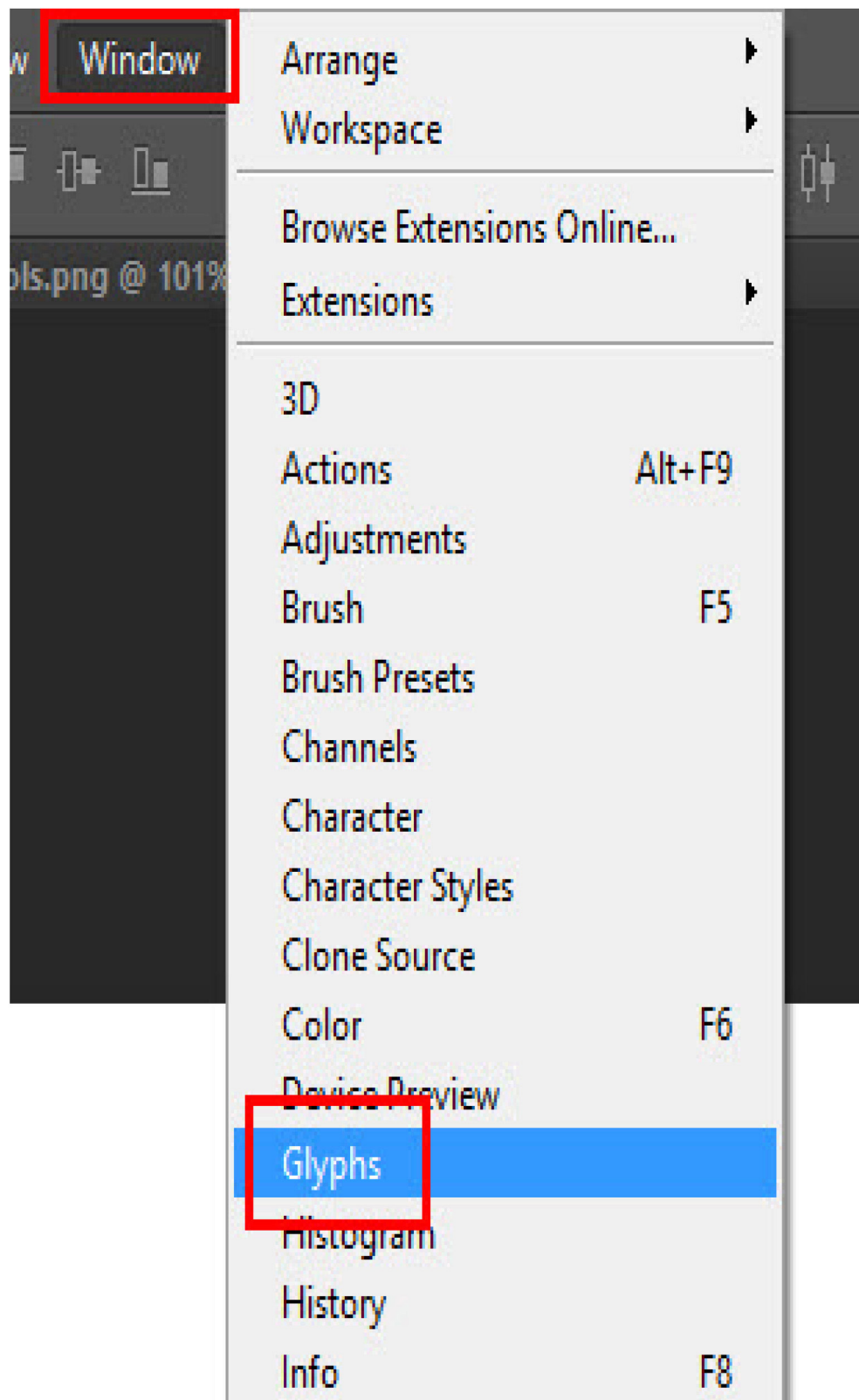

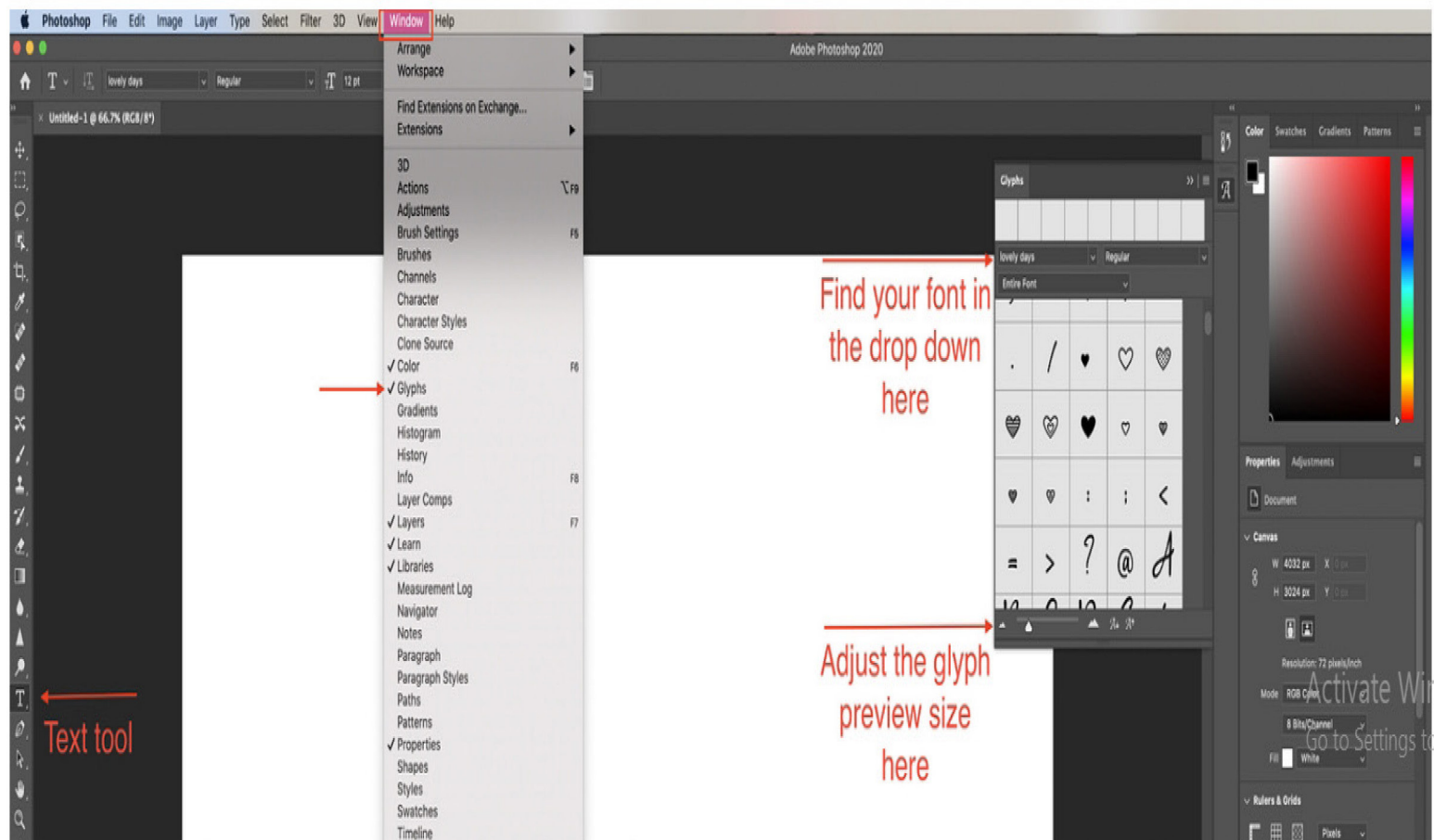

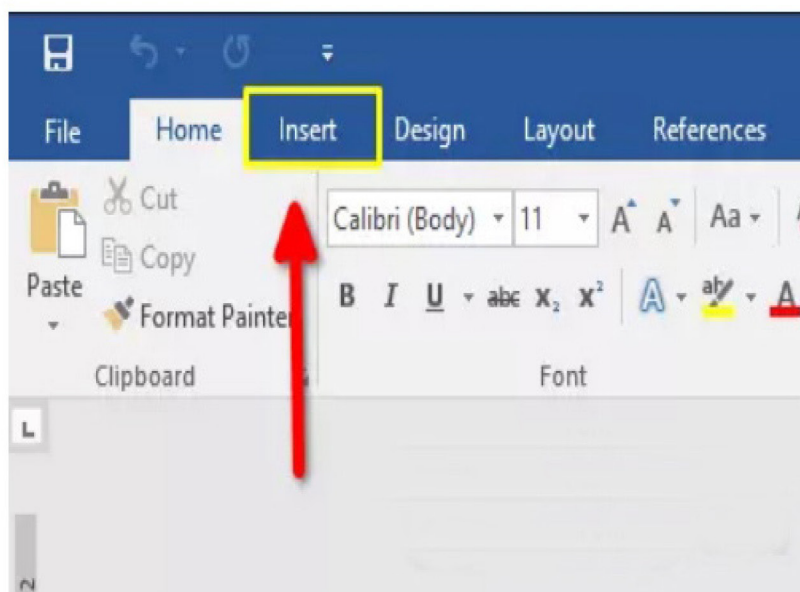
1. Click on the Window menu at the top.
2. From the drop-down menu choose the glyphs option.
3. A glyphs menu will appear.
4. Select your font using the font selector.
5. Select the text tool and type out your text.
6. If you would like to use an alternate glyph, double-click on your selected glyph from the menu to insert it.



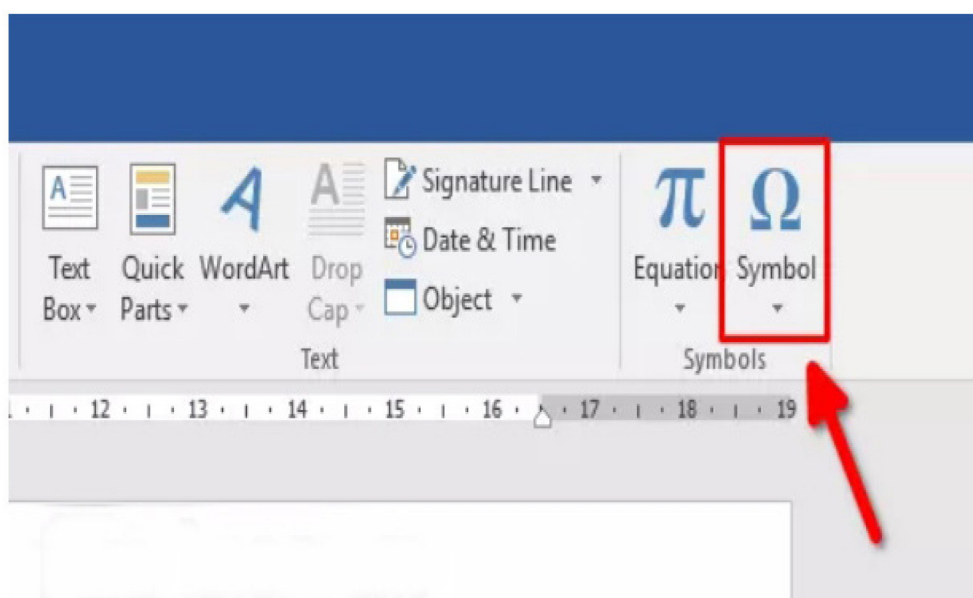

1. Click Tab **Insert** in Document word

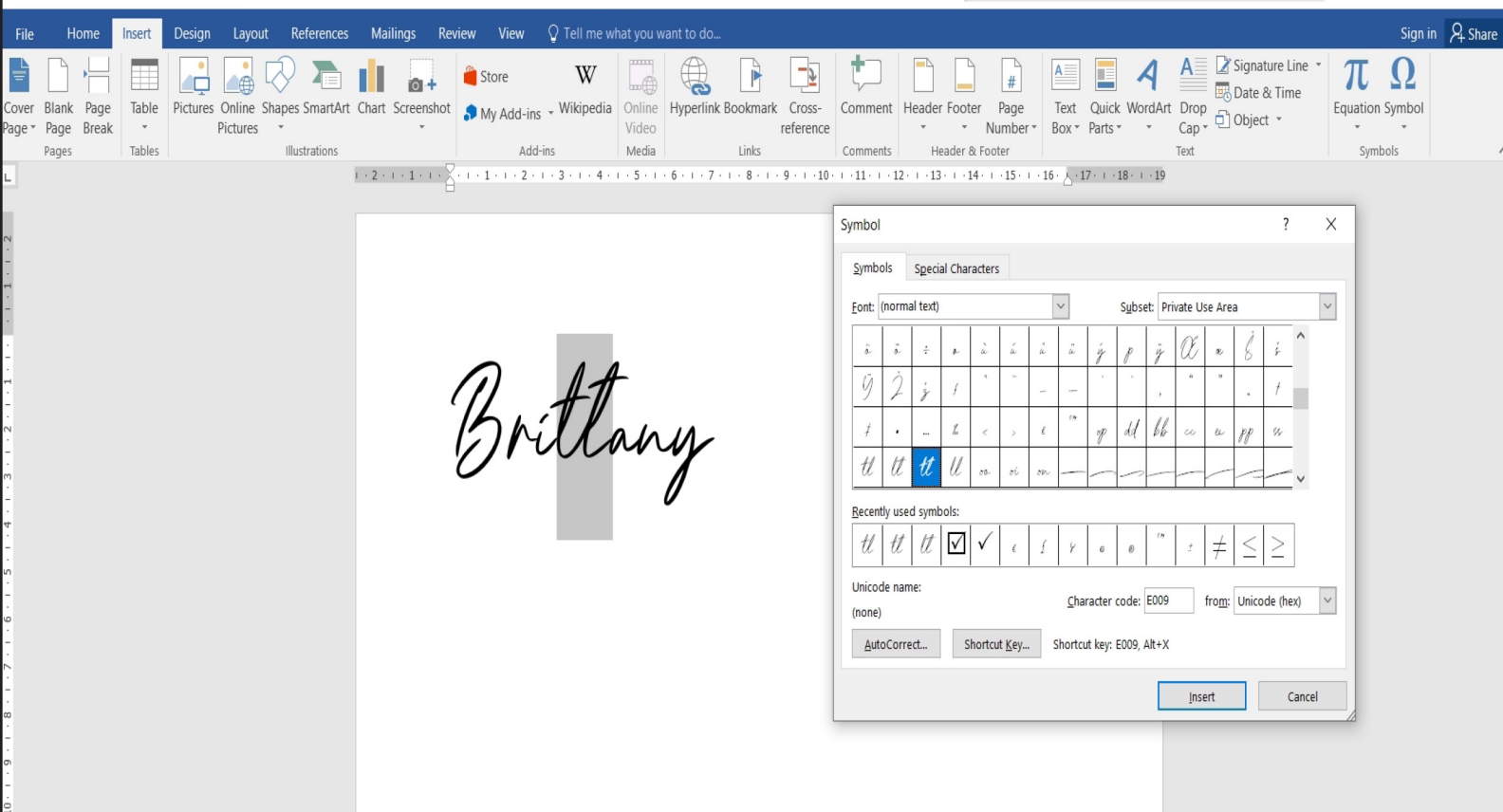
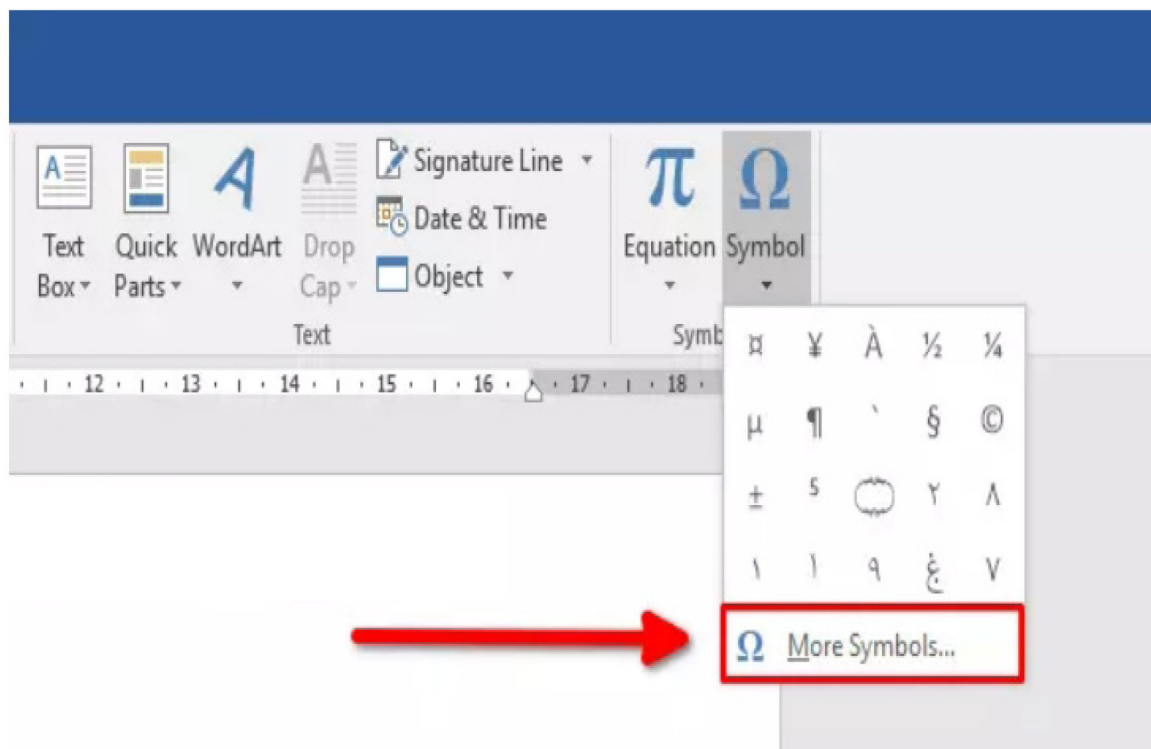


2. Click **Symbol**



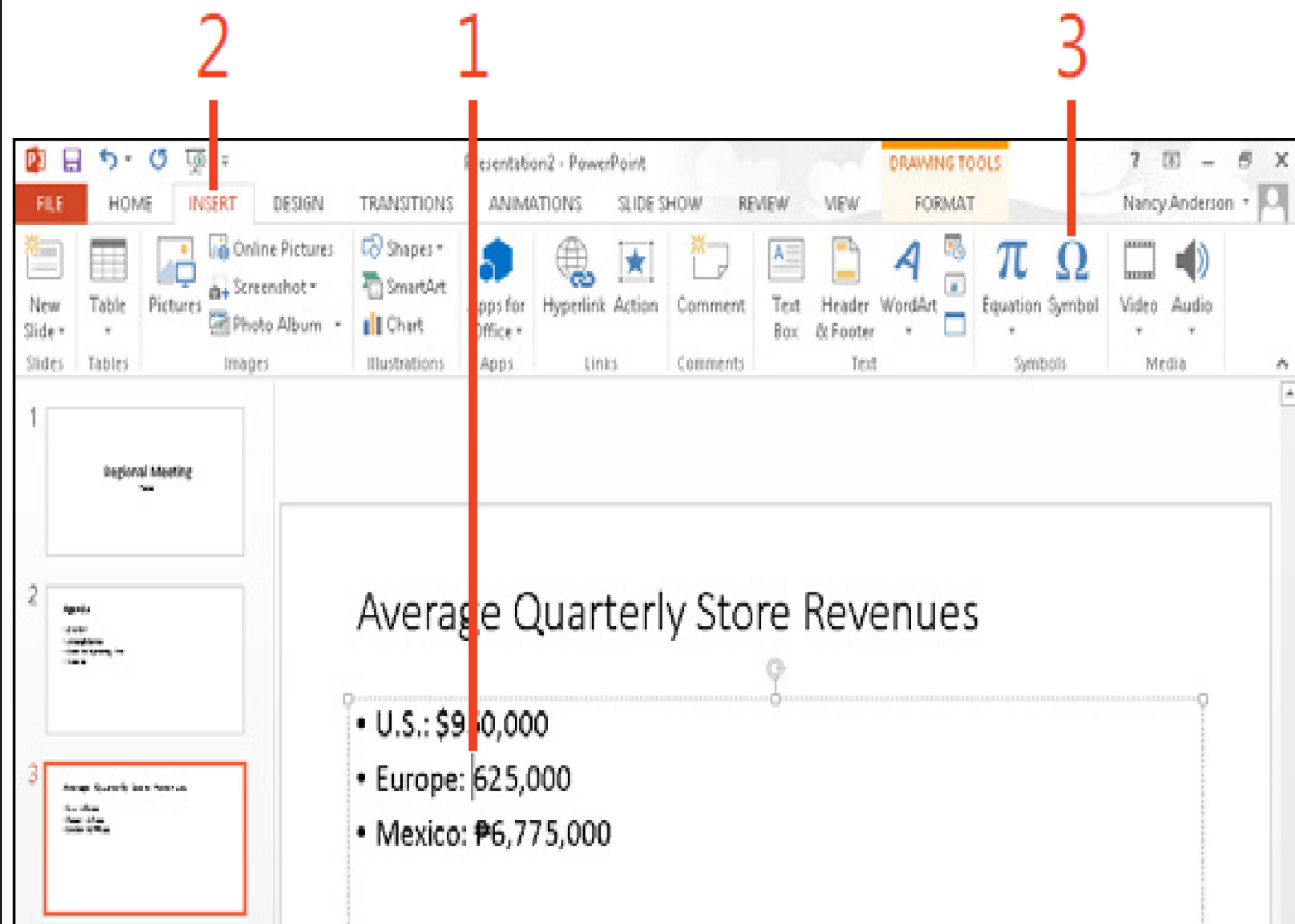
