HOW TO USE THE FONTS & ALTERNATES ON WINDOWS

Word, Publisher, Photoshop, Cricut, Silhouette, etc ;

There are two ways to use these fonts in Cricut.

1. The first is using the OTF or TTF. Using the OTF or TTF, all you have to do is install the font on your computer. Then going to your Cricut design space find the text icon click on the drop-down font and go to the system and find the name of the font you installed.
2. The other way is uploading the SVG, ungrouping the text, and you're done.

On Microsoft Word 2010 or later versions have a glyph panel where you can access the swashes & alternates.

1. First, select the correct font and go to Insert > More symbols > select the "Private Use Area"
2. Select the glyph of your choice and click Insert.

To access swashes & alternates on a Mac you can use Font Book.

1. Open the Font Book and choose the desired font
2. switch to 'repertoire view', it's the little icon at the top left with the grid/dots or click on 'view' > 'repertoire'. to see all glyphs
3. Now select and copy the glyph of your choice and paste it in your program. (Word, Publisher, Cricut, Silhouette, etc)

TIP FOR MS WORD USERS:

BE SURE TO HAVE 'KERNING FOR FONTS' ENABLED FOR PROPER LETTER SPACING.

HOW TO USE THE FONTS & ALTERNATES ON IPHONE / IPAD

If you go to the app store, search for IFont. (You can use their free version)

1.

Once you open the ifont app, select the button "files". Then, at the top left, you will see a button "import" click on this, please.

2.

When the box opens, search for the font and tap on the font, it will install it.

3.

Normally, the downloaded font will be located in "iCloud Drive," and you are supposed to see the font in the zip folder (tap on the zip folder).

4.

It will unzip the folder and show you the font. Select the font and click on the button: import to ifont.

5.

On the left side of the ifont app, I recommend changing the setting to "group by... to None + Sort by ... to Date Added, New to Old.

6.

Then, you will see the font on the left side. Click and ifont app; it will popup a box asking you to "Ignore" or "Allow." Click Allow.

7.

Lastly, a small box will ask you to go to your device setting to accept the new profile. All you have to do is: in setting, at the left side, click on "Profile Downloaded" and then on the Install button.

8.

That's it; your font will work on your iPad
